This is a reminder that Berlin Mennonite has Sunday School at 9:00 am, and the worship service starts at 10:00 am.

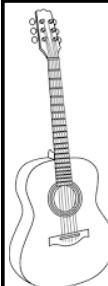
Salam, Hello - A Refugee Awareness Event
