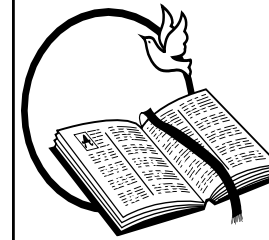

Additionally, for Noraa to have the opportunity to help train her own service dog is so exciting. The fact that this innovative program that Buckeye Service Dogs offers is in our own great state and within driving distance is beyond amazing.
