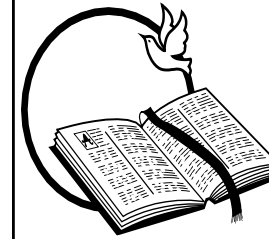

MCC Peace Camp for Young Adults
