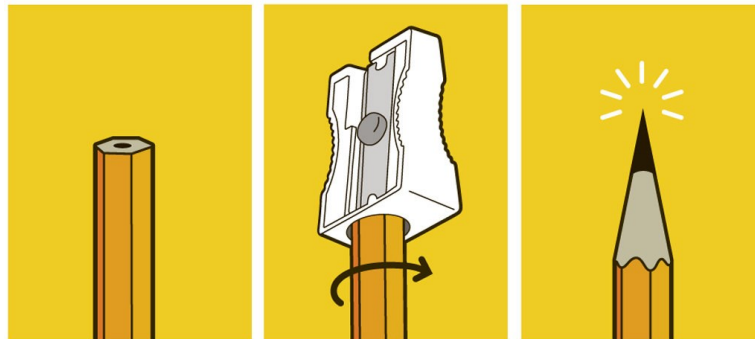
**Update from MMC Creation Care Group**

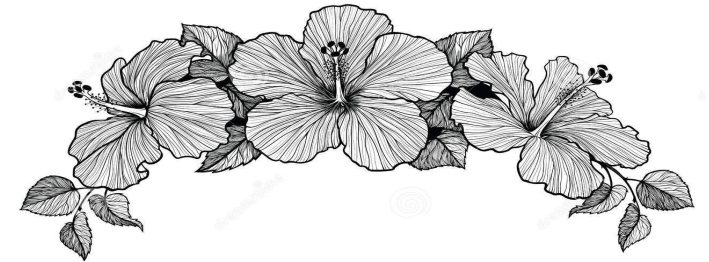
