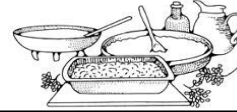

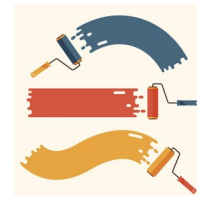

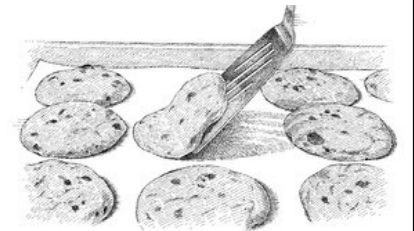
#### Camp Luz Fall Fest
